I, WILLIAM P. LEAR, of Reno, Washoe County, Nevada, being of sound and disposing mind and not acting under any duress, coercion, misrepresentation or fraud, do declare and publish this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all Wills and Codicils to Wills heretofore executed by me.

I.

I direct that all my just debts and expenses of last illness and funeral be paid as soon after my death as is practical.

II.

I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated to Sam Auld, Milton Weilenmann and Fran D. Jabara, as Trustees under that certain revocable trust executed by me and my wife Moya as Trustors and by the said Trustees on the 9th day of March, 1978, and entitled "The William P. Lear and Moya Olsen Lear Family Trust Agreement". The property passing hereunder shall be added to the property held in trust by said Trustees and shall become a part thereof, and administered and disposed of in accordance with the terms and conditions of said trust instrument as they exist at the time of my death.

III.

I hereby appoint my wife, Moya Olsen Lear, as the Executrix of this Will, to serve without bond. In the event she predeceases me or cannot act as Executrix, I appoint Sam Auld as Executor to serve without bond.
